

SAFE SCHOOL ASSURANCES

The Safe Schools Article of Act 26, effective in 1995, requires that prior to admission to school, "the parent, guardian or person having control or charge of a student, upon registration, provide a sworn statement or affirmation stating whether the pupil was previously suspended or expelled from any public or private school, in this Commonwealth or any other state for an act or offense involving weapons, alcohol or drugs, or for the willful infliction of injury to another person, or for any act of violence committed on school property. The registration shall be maintained as part of the student's disciplinary record." Any willful false statement made under the above section shall be a misdemeanor of the third degree.

Act 26 specifies “whenever a pupil transfers from one school to another, a certified copy of the student’s disciplinary record shall be transferred” The student (if 18 years of age or older) and/or the parents have the right to notification and to inspect such records, but they can not remove material in said records. Parents/Guardian has the right to enter a statement regarding a record or records.
