Dear Parent/Guardian,

TCCS is experiencing an increased number of cases of COVID19 over the last two weeks in the elementary grades, primarily K4-6. We ask that you continue to monitor your child daily for symptoms that may be associated with COVID19 infection. Common symptoms of COVID19 include:

- Fever (100.0 or greater) or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Gastrointestinal symptoms; nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea

Not all individuals who have COVID develop a fever. Some only have common cold or allergy symptoms. If symptoms are present, please KEEP your child home and follow up with their provider. If your child develops symptoms during the school day that may be associated with COVID19, he or she will be sent home from school as advised by the Pennsylvania Department of Health. TCCS staff will provide education per our covid plan while students are home. Contact Mrs. Mahaney or Mr. Guerra with those questions.

Please contact me , the TCCS certified school nurse , if your child has been diagnosed with COVID19 or has had an exposure to COVID19 outside of school. It is important that we know of exposures prior to a child or adult entering school.

You will be notified by TCCS if your child is determined to be a close contact of a probable or confirmed case of COVID19. We thank you for your cooperation during this unprecedented time. TCCS follows the PA Health Department recommendations related to covid 19 in schools.
