TCCS UPDATE

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Please review the following important information regarding COVID-19.

If you have been notified that you are a close contact of a person who tested positive for COVID-19, you must quarantine for 14 days from the date of last contact with the individual *even if you remain symptom free or have a negative COVID-19 test*. If you develop symptoms, contact your provider. The Department of Health recommends testing for those exposed to a positive case of COVID-19.

If you have had a COVID-19 test and are waiting for results, *you must isolate at home until results are received*. If your 14 day quarantine period is over, you must continue to isolate until your results are received.

Please contact Susan Shiley, TCCS School Nurse, with any questions and to report exposures and COVID-19 test results.

Remember, it is essential that you stay home if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 for 10 days or until you receive a negative COVID test or clearance from your provider to return to school.
