WHY WOULD TCCS MOVE TO REMOTE TEACHING?

TCCS will flip to remote teaching/learning if any or all of the following become a reality.

1. If TCCS does not have adequate employees able to work to staff the building properly. Employees are teachers, paraprofessionals, bus/van drivers, cafeteria staff, maintenance staff, administrative staff, support staff, IU5 staff, consultant staff. We are working weekly to find substitute employees.
2. If the number of covid cases among TCCS families is so high that the PA Health Department regulations suggest remote learning K-6 or 7-12 or K-12 is required to prevent large outbreaks. We will examine all options.
3. If TCCS has more students in a three to five-day period who have been denied entry (out of school) due to PA health regulations than are attending in-person classes.
4. If a single grade (K-6) has over 60% - 70% of students denied entry due to PA health regulations TCCS may flip to remote for a specific grade K-6.

TCCS will stay in person unless any of these situations triggers the necessity for a flip to remote. We are committed to in-person learning, however, being so small and having K-12 students we face challenges that some larger schools may not face in this covid situation.
